SELECT REASON FOR REVIEW & PROVIDE REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:

- Already Received Award for 4 Years:** Students are only eligible to receive the IKIC grant for up to 4 years beginning from the year of first application submission. Students who wish to be considered beyond 4 years should submit the IKIC Grant Appeal form instead, which can be found at www.iknowican.org.
- Did Not Apply Within 1 Year:** Students must submit their first IKIC grant application within 1 year of high school graduation. Provide a copy of your high school transcript showing year of graduation.
- Did Not Graduate High School / Did Not Graduate from Columbus City Schools:** Students must be graduates of CCS. Submit your final high school transcript from a CCS high school showing graduation date.
- Did Not Pass OGT:** Students must pass all 5 parts of the OGT. Submit final high school transcript showing OGT results.
- Enrolled Part-Time in College:** Students must be enrolled full-time. Submit a copy of college schedule displaying full-time status.
- Low GPA:** High school seniors must have at least a 2.25 cumulative GPA and college students must have a 2.0 cumulative GPA. Submit your most recent or final copy of transcript displaying cumulative 2.0 GPA for college students or cumulative 2.25 GPA for high school students.
- Not Pell Eligible:** Students must be Pell Grant eligible. Submit your most recent FAFSA Student Aid Report or a financial aid award letter showing Pell Grant eligibility.
