COLUMBUS, OH – <u>I Know I Can</u>, Columbus' only non-profit organization focused on college and career readiness, today announced a state-of-the-art means to extend the reach of its services to Columbus students and their families. On Thursday, June 8, 2023, the organization will hold a dedication ceremony for the new I Know I Can College & Career Coach at <u>Bread Financial</u>, 3095 Loyalty Circle, from 4-6 p.m. ET. The Coach is a fully customized mobile unit designed to help students and families with the completion of college applications, financial aid forms, scholarship applications and career exploration. Attendees will be among the first to tour the vehicle and participate in demonstrations of the educational software and systems. Light refreshments will be provided.

"I Know I Can's College & Career Coach is an exciting next step in the delivery of our programs and services outside of the traditional academic day. We hope to expand our reach directly into communities where our students and families live, work, and play. This summer will be the first time our own fully-equipped 'coach' will tour central Ohio to provide broader access to important information and resources to help young people prepare for postsecondary success," said I Know I Can Executive Director Katina Fullen.

The College & Career Coach will allow I Know I Can advisors to work with community students and families to complete tasks such as college, scholarship and financial aid applications, career and college exploration, and more. Following the dedication ceremony, I Know I Can's College & Career Coach will hit the road to serve students and families, first rolling into the Summer College & Career Fest on June 13th from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Africentric Field House. The Coach will then host community engagement events throughout the summer and will continue to be used year-round to strengthen relationships and increase the organization's reach in the Columbus area.
