## Apply for Housing

After the confirmation fee is processed (may take up to 7 days), login to [My Akron](#) and look for the My Housing icon on the left access the housing application/contract. The freshman housing priority deadline is May 15!

Students who complete the Housing Application/Contract by the priority deadline (May 15) will have access to My College Roomie to find a roommate and will be able to participate in online room selection. Students who complete the contract after May 15 will be manually assigned a room by the housing staff. You'll be asked to list your preferred residence halls. ## Register for Orientation

## Placement Testing

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Placement testing for Math, Writing, and Reading helps determine the appropriate first course for you to take in the University of Akron's course sequence. Your ACT/SAT scores and choice of major determine your placement testing requirements. If you chose "test optional" and did not submit an ACT or SAT test score when you applied, you are encouraged to submit your test score now for placement purposes (submitting your scores will not change your admission status or your Presidential Scholarship award (if applicable)). If you would like to submit your test score(s), please send a copy to [admissions@uakron.edu](mailto:admissions@uakron.edu) or ask your high school counselor to submit them on your behalf.

You will receive your specific placement testing requirement via email no more than three business days after receiving your Advising & Registration Confirmation Email containing your New Roo Advising & Class Registration and New Roo Orientation date. This email will be sent to all email addresses on file, including your UA email address.

Your placement exam(s) must be completed prior to your Advising & Registration program. Failure to complete any exam(s) prior to your Advising & Registration program could result in a delay in your course registration.

## Verification

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Verification is the process by which the Office of Student Financial Aid confirms, through documentation, the accuracy of the information provided on your FAFSA. The U.S. Department of Education selects which FAFSAs universities are required to verify. The verification process ensures that eligible students receive all the financial aid to which they are entitled and prevents ineligible students from receiving aid to which they are not entitled.

**If your FAFSA was selected for verification, you will be notified in writing. New undergraduate students will receive a paper letter.**

## **Apply for a Federal Work Study Job**

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The Federal Work-Study Program is a federally funded, campus-based aid program designed to provide part-time jobs for eligible students with financial need.

All students, regardless of financial need, are eligible to seek a campus job, but students are only able to be hired under the Federal Work-Study Program if identified in your financial aid package. The Office of Student Financial Aid will send an award notification to eligible students with instructions for securing a job.

- Jobs are located both on and off-campus.
- Students are paid at least minimum wage. Some positions pay a higher wage.
- Students work around their class schedules.
- Students receive a bi-weekly paycheck for hours worked.

## **Transportation & Parking**

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Students in the Tuition Guarantee Program support parking and transportation services through a portion of their general fees, and are entitled to a parking permit at no additional charge, as well as unlimited access to the shuttle service.

Students (not in the tuition guarantee program) who take more than five credit hours in a semester on Main Campus are assessed a Transportation Fee for that term (\$175 for the fall and spring semesters, \$120 for summer). This fee allows students to receive a parking permit on request (at no additional charge), and allows students unlimited access to the shuttle service.

Students who are not assessed this fee based on enrollment can opt to pay it in order to receive a parking permit. All students who wish to receive a parking permit must fill out an application and register a vehicle. You will need to know your license plate number to apply for a permit.

## **Student Health Insurance & Proof of Immunization**

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All registered domestic students taking six or more credit hours are eligible to enroll in a student health and basic accident plan administered through an outside insurance agent, Assured Partners. The plan is underwritten by Student Educational Benefit Trust (SEBT). It is a voluntary program that domestic students may choose to enroll in if they find the coverage adequate for their needs.
