Apply for Housing

If you plan to live on campus, you will need to apply for housing. You can log into MyBGSU > Housing & Residence Life > My Room and Meals to submit your housing application and make your initial \$200 payment (This payment is applied to your bill later on if you attend BGSU). ***This is your first step in committing to Bowling Green State University.***

Register for Orientation (SOAR)

SOAR, "Student Orientation, Advising and Registration", is the first step of your orientation experience at BGSU!

This informative, one-day program (created for first-year/freshman students and their transitional needs) serves as your personal introduction and transition to BGSU. Our goal is to provide you, your family, and guests with an overview of university expectations and resources. In addition to meeting with an academic advisor and registering for your classes, you will meet other incoming students, current student leaders, and staff who will become an important part of your college experience. New first-year/freshman students admitted to BGSU for the summer/fall will be notified by email in early March or upon admission with instructions and details related to signing up for SOAR.

Placement Testing

Prior to registration and beginning classes at BGSU, new students may be required to complete a Placement Test in the following subject areas: Writing, Math, Foreign Language and/or Music Theory. Your academic major or minor, ACT/SAT scores, Advanced Placement (AP) credit, and any prior high school and college-level courses you have taken will determine which Placement Tests you need to complete.

Verification

Verification is the process of reviewing the information reported on the FAFSA for accuracy. If your application is selected, Student Financial Aid (SFA) is required to collect certain financial documents (e.g., federal tax transcripts) from you and your parents or spouse, if applicable. Information from these documents are compared to your FAFSA information and corrections are made when necessary. SFA may select applicants for verification to correct any conflicting information.

Student Health Insurance

All BGSU students who are enrolled in eight or more credit hours, and all international students (regardless of credit hours), are required to have health insurance coverage.

If you already have insurance coverage, you can waive BGSU's student health insurance by going to MyBGSU>Financials>Student Insurance Requirement. If you forget to tell BGSU that you have health insurance, you will be automatically enrolled and charged for the insurance program. If you need health insurance coverage, you can enroll in BGSU's student insurance plan.
