## Register for Orientation (SOAR)

Each year, the Office of Admissions hosts in-person and virtual Student Orientation, Advising, and Registration (SOAR) events to introduce you to our programs and support services. To be eligible to attend SOAR, the Office of Admissions must have a record of your orientation and housing fees (matriculation and orientation fee of \$105, room key fee of \$135, and room reservation fee of \$60).

#### Verification

Some FAFSA applications are selected for a process called "verification," either by random selection or because of conflicting information on the FAFSA. If your application is selected for verification by your schools' financial aid office, they will likely request certain documents from you. The purpose of verification is to make sure accurate information is provided on the FAFSA. Be sure to check your email and other communications from Central State to see if you have been selected for verification.

#### Apply for a Federal Work Study Job

The Federal Work-Study Program is a federally funded, campus-based aid program designed to provide part-time jobs for eligible students with financial need. All students, regardless of financial need, are eligible to seek a campus job, but students are only able to be hired under the Federal Work-Study Program if identified in your financial aid package.
