Apply for Housing

All first and second-year students who live outside of a 25-mile radius from UT are required to live on campus and participate in the meal plan program.

Students who reside within a 25-mile radius can choose to live on campus, but it is not required. UT requires a \$100 enrollment deposit, a \$100 housing pre-payment (deposit) and a \$40 housing application fee (for students living on campus).

You can make these deposits as soon as you are admitted, deposits can be made through your MyUT portal, on the "New Student" tab.

Verification

Some applications are selected for a process called "verification," either by random selection or because of conflicting information on the FAFSA. If your application is selected for verification by our office we will request certain documents from you beginning with the Verification Worksheet, signed copies of your federal tax return, and your parents' signed tax return (if you are a dependent student). The purpose of verification is to make sure accurate information is provided on the FAFSA. The bottom line is that we want to make sure you're receiving the very most in financial aid for which you're eligible, and verification helps ensure that you are.
